General Information

This juried art show will exhibit original work reflecting the theme "I Come, O Savior to Thy Table" and based on the theme *I Come, O Savior to Thy Table*.

Christ's true body and blood are some of God's greatest gifts! How so? Luther writes, "In the Sacrament forgiveness of sins, life and salvation are given to us."

The art exhibition *I Come O Savior to Thy Table* is designed to highlight and celebrate the theme of God's gifts of forgiveness and renewal through the sacrament of Holy Communion. We reflect on Jesus words in Matthew 26:26-27. "Now as they were eating, Jesus took bread, and after blessing it broke it and gave it to the disciples and said, 'Take eat; this is my body.' And he took a cup, and when he had given thanks he gave it to them saying, 'Drink of it all of you, for this is my blood of the covenant, which is poured out for many for the forgiveness of sins.'" As we consider our sinful state, we rejoice in the forgiveness that Christ offers through his very body and blood.

Artwork in any medium may be entered in the show, however space limitations may prohibit the consideration of large-scale works.

Eligibility

Members and friends of St. Michael Lutheran Church family are invited to enter up to two original works for adjudication.

- Work that is not included in *I Come O Savior to Thy Table* must be picked up in Luther Hall on Monday, June 10 from 9:00a to 4:00p.
- The *I Come O Savior to Thy Table* art exhibit will open on Sunday, June 15 and run through Sunday, July 14. Artists whose work is featured in the exhibit will be invited to attend a reception from noon-2p on June 15th.
- Work included in the exhibit must be picked up on from St. Michael's lobby on Monday, July 15 from 9:00a-4:00p.
